Enterprise Drive Construction Incentive Program



Up to \$44,200 in rebates are available for qualified construction projects on the city owned lots along Enterprise Drive.

Rebates will be awarded to qualified applicants based on the estimated taxable value of the property once construction is complete. Only city-owned lots along Enterprise Drive zoned as B3 (light commercial) qualify for this program.

- Brush, Leaves and Grass Clippings Only, Please.
 - Leaves & Grass Clippings Pile is the lower pile on the right Side
 - Trees and Brush Pile is the pile located higher up on the right side
 - West on County Rd. 2 at the lights. Take the first gravel road (Mind Drive) on the right after the Root River Bridge. You will find a gate to the dump on the right side of the road.
 - Wednesday 1-4 PM, Friday 1-4 PM & Saturday 10 AM—4 PM
- For safety purposes, hunting is not allowed on the brush & leaf dump property. The brush & leaf dump will close after the first snowfall.
