Enterprise Drive Construction Incentive Program



Up to \$44,200 in rebates are available for qualified construction projects on the city owned lots along Enterprise Drive.

Rebates will be awarded to qualified applicants based on the estimated taxable value of the property once construction is complete. Only city-owned lots along Enterprise Drive zoned as B3

(light commercial) qualify for this program.
