Elections—Your Vote Counts

- Tuesday, November 2nd—Polls will be open from 7:00 am—8:00 pm at **Chatfield City Hall—21 SE Second Street, Chatfield MN 55923**

On November 2, Chatfield area residents will be asked to vote on a single ballot question seeking a renewal of the school district's current operating levy of \$476 per student. This will help the district manage projected deficits of \$430,000 annually beginning next year, stabilize the districts finances, and keep the tax impact on residents approximately the same.

Public Works Fall & Winter Reminders

- **Fall street sweeping** begins the week on 10/25. This process takes approximately two weeks. Please remove vehicles from the streets when you see the sweeper in your neighborhood.
- The **brush & leaf dump** will close with the first plowable snowfall.
- **Remove all portable basketball hoops from the public right of way and sidewalks** before plowing season starts.
- **Sidewalks** need to be cleared as quickly and completely as possible after a snowfall.
- **Please do not park on the City Streets if snow is in the forecast.** Sign up for Citizen Alert Notifications at www.ci.chatfield.mn.us
- **No parking on city streets when plows are operating.** Tickets will be issued and cars may be towed if parked cars interfere with snowplowing or snow removal. *We do our best to place a community announcement on KTTC & send a citizen alert the evening prior to plowing whenever the weather allows us to know ahead of time. The best practice is to not park on the City Streets if snow is in the forecast.*



Auto-Pay & Online Payments Available

Residents looking for a convenient way to pay their utility bill each month should consider signing up for Automatic Bill Payment. Auto-Pay participants have funds automatically deducted from their account. Auto-Pay avoids the hassle of writing checks, paying for postage, and mailing your utility bill.

Simply complete an authorization form (available on website) and attach a voided check or savings deposit slips to sign up. Call 867-3810 with any questions.

Online payment options are also available 24/7 by clicking on the Pay online icon at www.ci.chafield.mn.us. In addition to being able to check your utility account balance and make your utility bill payment, you can pay for animal fines, parking fines, camping fees and make donations to ambulance, fire, library, parks & police.
