**Request:** Develop recommendations regarding the use of the one-time allocation of Public Safety Aid from the 2023 legislative session.

**Background:** The City is expected to receive \$131,715 from the State of Minnesota in 2024 as part of the Public Safety Aid program.

Eligible uses include:

- community violence prevention and intervention programs;
- community engagement;
- mental health crisis responses;
- victim services;
- training programs;
- first responder wellness;
- equipment related to fire, rescue, and emergency services;
- or to pay other personnel or equipment costs.

Since this is a one-time payment, it is important that there be no financial tails associated with the use of the funds.
