### INTERPRETIVE SIGN PROJECT



The Heritage Preservation Commission (HPC) has been awarded a federal grant to increase public awareness and appreciation for historically significant buildings and sites by creating eight outdoor interpretive signs to be installed on public property at key points of interest within the downtown area.

- 1) Does the sign panel grab your attention?
- 2) Is the layout logical and easy to follow?

- 4) Is the text accurate and the spelling, grammar, and syntax correct?
- 5) Do you think the signs will make visitors and residents aware of Chatfield's historical, architectural, and cultural heritage?
- 6) If the city adds more interpretive signs in the future, where should they go and what topics should they address?

#### Filing Dates

File an Affidavit of Candidacy in the City Clerk's Office between July 28th & August 11th, 2020  
(Monday -Friday between 8:00 a.m.—4:30 p.m.)

#### Qualifications

- A resident of the city for 30 days before the general election and has not filed for any other office in the same election.
- Must be a qualified voter in the State of Minnesota.
- Candidates filing for office must be 21 years of age or more when assuming office.

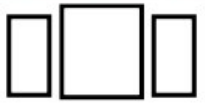
