
## **DROUGHT WARNING** PLEASE CONSERVE WATER

## Be An EMT....EMT Training Class Begins Monday, September 11th



An initial EMT training course will begin Monday, 09/11 and run through Thursday, 12/14 with the NREMT practical exam. Classes will be held from 6:00 pm—10:00pm Monday and Thursday and one Saturday a month from 8:00 am-4:00 pm. Class is limited to 12 participants.

After successful completion of the course, candidates should have the AMBULANCE knowledge to pass the NREMT exam. Candidates, must be self-motivated and participate in all classes. Classes are held at Chatfield City Hall. The \$1,200 cost includes: CPR card, text book, work book, practical test and a NREMT practice test.
