## LEAKS CAN RUN, BUT THEY CAN'T HIDE

Are you ready to chase down leaks? Household leaks can waste more than 1 trillion gallons of water annually nationwide, so each year we hunt down the drips during Fix a Leak Week. Mark your calendars for EPA's tenth annual Fix a Leak Week which will take place March 18 through 24, 2019. You can find and fix leaks

inside and outside your home to save valuable water and money all year long. Fix a Leak Week is celebrated in March of each year as a time to remind Americans to check their household fixtures and irrigation systems for leaks.

#### THE FACTS ON LEAKS:

The average household's leaks can account for more than 10,000 gallons of water wasted every year and ten percent of homes have leaks that waste 90 gallons or more per day. Common types of leaks found in the home are worn toilet flappers, dripping faucets, and other leaking valves. These types of leaks are often easy to fix, requiring only a few tools and hardware that can pay for themselves in water savings. Fixing easily corrected household water leaks can save homeowners about 10 percent on their water bills.

#### HERE ARE SOME TIPS FOR FINDING LEAKS:

- Take a look at your water usage during a colder month, such as January or February. If a family of four exceeds 12,000 gallons per month, there are serious leaks.
- Check your water meter before and after a two-hour period when no water is being used. If the meter changes at all, you probably have a leak.
- Identify toilet leaks by placing a drop of food coloring in the toilet tank. If any color shows up in the bowl after 10 minutes, you have a leak. (Be sure to flush immediately after the experiment to avoid staining the tank.)
- Examine faucet gaskets and pipe fittings for any water on the outside of the pipe to check for surface leaks.

#### SHOVELING- HYDRANTS, SIDEWALK RAMPS & STORM DRAINS

Extra help is needed this year to clear the fire hydrants, sidewalk access ramps & the storm drains.

If there is a **fire hydrant** near your house, please keep it accessible. In an emergency, every second counts.

Remove any snow and ice from the hydrant, clear a wide enough perimeter around the hydrant for firefighters to work (about 3 feet), and clear a path from the street to the



Sidewalks need to be cleared as quickly and completely as possible after a snowfall (within 24 hours). Please do not forget about **sidewalk curb ramps** on corner lots and other curb cutouts. Residents are responsible for providing access from the street onto the sidewalk.

Please also clear away any snow that may be blocking a **storm drain** so when the thawing temperatures arrive the melting snow will clear the streets without creating large puddles and street flooding.


