Park & Rec Committee September 25, 2023

The Park & Recreation committee met on Monday, September 25, 2023.

Ventrac Mower Acquisition: Burkholder suggested moving forward with the Ventrac mower in 2024 with the total cost after trade in of \$30,990. The existing mower will be traded in. The approval to purchase a new mower not to exceed \$36,000 was given April 10, 2023, therefore no additional approval is needed.

Pool – Slushy Machine: Due to ongoing maintenance as well as the lack of revenue generated from the slushy machine, the equipment will be removed. The supervisor will determine other items that are prepackaged. The machine will be sold via Public Surplus.

Grooming ballparks at Mill Creek Park: There are no new updates to this discussion. The city does not have the equipment nor the staff time currently in order to accommodate this request. Should something change in the future the discussion can be brought back to the committee.

Groen Park Bridge Update: Craig Britton provided an update on the project. A recommendation will be sent to the city Council to contract with Widseth to complete the hydraulic analysis report as required in order to obtain a permit to complete the project. The goal is to install the bridge in November of this year.

Action Requested: To discuss and consider the construction of a batting cage to be built in Mill Creek Park next to the south ballfield.

Background: Chris Dornack has approached the city and school district about constructing a batting cage next the south ballfield in Mill Creek Park for the use by the High School and the baseball association

I was provided a quote for the netting, the fence install, grading/prep and install of ball diamond sand. (attached)

It was mentioned that the total cost would split 3 ways between the Association, School District and the City of Chatfield. I did suggest to Chris to apply for the Operation Round up Grant through Peoples Energy Cooperative to help off-set some cost. I suggested requesting for half of the cost.

We will wait to hear back on the outcome of the grant and any other cost changes that may come up. I believe Chris is looking for this to be a Springtime project.

HORSMAN FENCING will assist the customer, upon request, in determining where the fence is to be erected, but under no circumstances does HORSMAN FENCE assume any responsibility concerning property lines or in any way guarantee their accuracy. If property pins cannot be located it is recommended that the customer have the property surveyed.

HORSMAN FENCING will assume the responsibility for having underground public utilities located and marked. However, HORSMAN FENCING assumes no responsibility for unmarked sprinkler lines, or any other unmarked buried lines or objects. The customer will assume all liability for any damage caused by directing HORSMAN FENCING to dig in the immediate vicinity of known utilities.

The final billing will be based on the actual footage of fencing built and the work performed. Partial billing for materials delivered to the job site and work completed may be sent at weekly intervals. Adjustments for material used on this job and adjustments for labor will be charged or credited at the currently established rates. Additional charges for any extra work not covered in this contract that was requested by the customer will also be added. The full amount of this contract along with any additional charges will become payable upon completion of all work whether or not it has been invoiced.

A finance charge of 1 1/2% per month (or a minimum of \$1.00), which is an annual percentage rate of 18%, shall be applied to accounts that are not paid within 30 days after completion of any work invoiced. All materials will remain the property of HORSMAN FENCING until all invoices pertaining to this job are paid in full.

Right of access and removal is granted to HORSMAN FENCING in the event of non-payment under the terms of this contract. The customer agrees to pay all interest and any costs incurred in the collection of this debt.
