BECOME AN ELECTION JUDGE

If you want to serve your community, maybe becoming an Election Judge is the way for you! **Qualifications:** Be a U.S. citizen; Be an eligible voter; Able to read, write, & speak English; Be appointed by the City Council; Be trained and certified as an election judge. Training will be provided. **Not Eligible:** Candidates in that election; Husband, wife, parent, child, brother or sister of a candidate or another judge in the same precinct.

HIGH SCHOOL STUDENT: 16 and 17-year-old students can work as election judge trainees. It's a great way to learn about elections and voting.

Reminder - Keep Grass Clippings off the Street & other Paved Areas

Stormwater, Drinking water, Lake & Rivers are all connected. Removing grass clippings off the Street and sidewalks is one step in protecting our fresh water.

Grass clippings are not to be deposited on to the city streets. Please help keep our community safe by disposing of grass clippings properly.

BENEFITS OF RECYCLING LAWN CLIPPINGS TO THE LAWN

- 1. Regular mowing will greatly reduce the need to collect clippings.
- 2. It's best to leave clippings on your lawn as mulch to bring essential nutrients back to your lawn.
- 3. Adding the organic matter from clippings may help improve your soil if it is sandy or heavy clay.

Grass clippings blown into the roadway can create dangerous conditions for our community, motorcyclist and bicyclists.

How- grass clippings reduce traction by creating a slick surface and it reduces the effectiveness of braking, because of the loss of surface friction.
