- **Brush, Leaves and Grass Clippings Only, Please.**
 - *Leaves & Grass Clippings Pile is the lower pile on the right side*
 - *Trees and Brush Pile is the pile located higher up on the right side*
- West on County Rd. 2 at the lights. Take the first gravel road (Mind Drive) on the right after the Root River Bridge. You will find a gate to the dump on the right side of the road.
- Wednesday 1-4 PM, Friday 1-4 PM & Saturday 10 AM—4 PM

For safety purposes, hunting is not allowed on the brush & leaf dump property. The brush & leaf dump will close after the first snowfall.
