Winter Reminders

Sidewalks need to be cleared as quickly and completely as possible after a snowfall. No parking on city streets when plows are operating.

Parking tickets will be issued and cars may be towed if parked cars interfere with snowplowing or snow removal.

Also, **disconnect hoses** from your outside faucets and shut off the valve for the outside faucet that is inside your house.



Citizen Alert System

The City of Chatfield along with the Olmsted County Sheriff's Department are now able to provide you with notifications during emergency situations. By signing up with this system, you can be notified of situations like snowplowing, water breaks and street closings. When you enroll in this system you choose how you want to be notified. The City is especially pleased to be able to provide this service as a way to work with those who routinely park on the streets to receive notifications that vehicles need to be removed from the street for snow plowing.

1. Either choose **Government | City Services | Citizen Alert System** from the navigation drop down menus or click on the **Citizen Alert Notification icon** on the brown filmstrip. This will take you to the City of Rochester's web site enrollment page.



3. Complete name and contact method info Enter Chatfield in desired alerting area—click Go—and select Chatfield City in dropdown



5. Under Manage Groups click the + by Chatfield groups / topics you are interested in receiving notifications for.

4. Click the + under Distribution Groups and choose City of Chatfield



6. Follow the prompts & reply to the verification messages.
