Elections—Your Vote Counts



On Tuesday, November 6th, election polls will be open from 7:00 am—8:00 pm. In addition to state and federal elections, this election will also fill the City Council and Chatfield Public School Board.

At the City, two people have filed for mayor, Russell Smith and Dan Folken. The term of office for the Mayor is for two years.

Two seats are open for City Council, which are four year terms. Paul Novotny and Mike Urban have filed for re-election and they are the only ones who filed for those offices.

Water & Sewer Line Warranty Program



Within the next several weeks, residents in Chatfield will receive a solicitation from Service Line Warranties of America (SLWA) for a program that is designed to provide financial assistance in the event that repairs are needed to exterior water and sewer/septic lines. Many homeowners are not aware that they are responsible to pay

for repairs to water and sewer service lines that connect their home to the city's water and sewer mains, and those repairs can be very costly. SLWA is completely responsible for the services they are offering and the City will not be involved with selling or providing these services. These plans are completely optional and it is not required that any homeowner purchase the services. Because water and sewer lines do need to be repaired or replaced at some point, though, the City did want to make this service available to anyone who might want the service. Complete details will be provided by SLWA in the near future.
