No Wipes Down the Pipes!!!



Please, <u>don't</u> flush wipes down the toilet! The <u>only</u> thing that should be flushed is toilet paper. It is the only paper designed to break down as it travels through the wastewater treatment process.

Even if products are labeled as "flushable," don't do it! Baby wipes, adult wipes, cleaning wipes—none of them should be flushed. Wipes are clogging wastewater systems all across the land, including right here in Chatfield. These items clog the pipes before they get to the treatment plant and cause costly backups to friends and neighbors. **NO WIPES DOWN THE PIPES!!**
