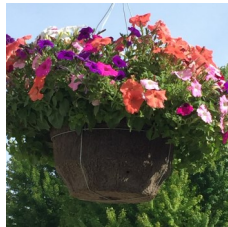

FILE FOR CITY COUNCIL



If you have ever wanted to serve your community as an elected official, the time to file for office is from August 2—August 16 at the City Clerk's office, from 8:00 a.m.-4:30 p.m. Monday through Friday.

The two year Mayor term and three City Council seats (4 year term) are open this year. Any person may be a candidate who is: eligible to vote, will be at least 21 years old on assuming office, will have been a resident of the city for 30 days before the general election and has not filed for any other office for the same election (can only be on the ballot for one office at a time).

PRIMARY ELECTION



A primary election determines which candidates will be on the ballot in the November general election.

The Minnesota primary election day is Tuesday, August 9th.

The polls will be open from 7:00 a.m.—8:00 p.m.

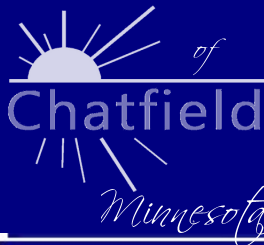
