The City is upgrading the water meter system. The current meters and meter reading system is 23+ years old.

means every home connected to City water will have two pieces of hardware in the utility room inside the house replaced, The meter and the setter (the piece of plumbing that holds the meter).

You will be receiving a letter in the mail with more detail and the names of the companies that will need to enter your home. Following is a summary of what will be happening between mid November and the end of the year;

- A letter will arrive in the mail with a telephone number for you to call and schedule the installation.
- Before installation please clear the area around your current meter to allow working space for the installer. Also, please make sure that the existing piping is in serviceable condition.

VOTE On Tuesday, November 8th, election polls will be open from 2016 7:00 am—8:00 pm. In addition to state and federal elections, this election will also fill the City Council and Chatfield Public School Board.

Three seats are open for City Council, which are four year terms. One person, Joshua Broadwater, has filed for the City Council.
