Donate a Picnic Table to the Park!

Over the past few months, after looking at various picnic table vendors and comparing them to the wooden tables that have been used in the parks over the years, it has been determined that it is time to make an upgrade.

The City has purchased two tables to show people what the new tables are like. As people will see, the new tables are much more user friendly, they will be more durable and they look great, too!

Just like the benches that have been donated for the trail system, it is hoped that people will consider donating picnic tables to help upgrade the parks.



To get the table donation effort started, and as a gesture of appreciation to the community, the city

employees have pooled almost \$800 in cash donations to provide the first picnic table donation! They hope that many other people and service groups follow suit, as we need over sixty tables to upgrade all of the entire inventory. What a great gift to make to your community at this time of year!
