WATER & SEWER RATES

City residents and businesses will notice a slight change on utility bills this month, primarily because new rates will go into effect. Water rates have increased by 4.5% and sewer rates have increased by 3.0%. The City regrets any inconvenience this might cause.

Also, due to a new Transit Sales & Use tax imposed by Fillmore County, commercial accounts in the Fillmore side of the community will see a new line item as the City is required to collect this fee, in the amount of .05%.


