The event is meant to increase awareness about police programs in communities, such as drug prevention, town watch, neighborhood watch, and other anti-crime efforts.

Chatfield will take part in the event on Tuesday, August 6th, with activity in City Park that will include the Police Department. the Fire Department and the Ambulance Service.

Children, adults, and families are encouraged to participate as this is an excellent opportunity to meet some of the police officers and to inspect the squad cars. There will also be opportunities to

meet members of the fire department and EMTs who volunteer in the Ambulance Service. People will be able to check out the actual fire trucks and ambulances, too.
