Dog & Cat Licensing & Regulations

All dogs and cats that are at least six months old are required to be licensed. Licenses are due by July 1 of each year. Each license is \$10 per year for neutered or spayed animals and \$20 per year if not neutered or spayed. To purchase a license, be prepared to show proof of your pet's rabies vaccination when you stop at the City Clerk's office

Each residence is allowed a total of 4 pets, but no more than 2 of a species. So there may be 2 dogs and 2 cats at a residence, but 3 dogs and 1 cat or 1 dog and 3 cats would be in violation.

Please remember: Pick up after your dog when walking around town or running in the parks. Cats & dogs are not allowed to run at large and should be under the control of the owner at all times, even when in the parks. Any dog or cat found to be running at large in the City will be picked up and placed in the animal pound.

Construction Projects

Hillside Drive Project: In addition to the actual street that is named "Hillside Drive," this project includes the construction of the water booster station and the water and sewer mains that are underneath the streets. This project was declared substantially complete in October, almost two weeks ahead of schedule. Manholes are currently being raised in anticipation of the final layer of blacktop.

Water Tower Project: The painting of the water tower is underway and the engineers report that this project is ahead of schedule and within budget.

Burr Oak Avenue: This project is scheduled to begin the first week of June and will result in one more access point to Highway 52 for residents.
