The Chatfield Public Library : Did you know that...

 the library's collection includes books, audio books on tape and CD, music CDs, DVDs, videos, reference materials, magazines, newspapers, and pamphlets for all ages? Most of these items can be checked out. If you want something the library does not have, you can request it from other libraries in the southeast region and beyond! All you need is a library card and library cards are free!

- the library offers free computer classes for seniors? We just finished our second round of Senior Techies classes covering computer basics, introduction to email, and introduction to searching the Internet. If you are interested in attending future classes, please call the library at 867-3480 and get on the list!
- a volunteer delivers library materials to the Chosen Valley Care Center and Assisted Living every week? The library provides personalized selection and record keeping of materials to match the needs and interests of any resident who desires this service.
- preschoolers through teens can take part in our Summer Reading Program? Elementary children's programs are offered each Tuesday at 1:00 p.m. and story times take place each Friday at 9:30 a.m. through July 27th. All ages can turn in reading logs to earn prizes.
- · adults get their own special reading program in the winter? "Hot Reads for Cold Nights" gives adults rewards for reading and using the library!
- the library provides free wireless access? Bring in your laptop and plunk down anywhere to use the internet. There are also 7 computers, all with internet access, available for public use.
- that you can make color and black and white copies, send and receive faxes, and pick up tax forms at the library?
- that there is a meeting room available to nonprofit groups? Use is free and a variety of audiovisual equipment is available.

Utility Bill / Auto Pay

You can save yourself a stamp and a check each month by signing up to have your City Utility Bill automatically withdrawn from your bank account (checking or savings) each month.

To get started, all you need to do is complete a Direct Utility Payment Authorization form and submit a voided check. This form is available at www.ci.chatfield.mn.us or at the City Clerk's office. Just stop by or call Mary at 867-3810.

If you choose to continue to pay with cash or check, please return the top portion of the bill with your payment-it helps ensure that your payment gets applied to the proper account. Thank You!
