#### **Dog & Cat Licensing & Regulations**

All dogs and cats that are at least six months old are required to be licensed. Licenses are due by July 1 of each year. Each license is \$10 per year for neutered or spayed animals and \$20 per year if not neutered or spayed. To purchase a license, be prepared to show proof of your pet's rabies vaccination when you stop at the City Clerk's office

Each residence is allowed a total of 4 pets, but no more than 2 of a species. So there may be 2 dogs and 2 cats at a residence, but 3 dogs and 1 cat or 1 dog and 3 cats would be in violation.

**Please remember**: Pick up after your dog when walking around town or running in the parks. Cats & dogs are not allowed to run at large and should be under the control of the owner at all times, even when in the parks. Any dog or cat found to be running at large in the City will be picked up and placed in the animal pound.

#### PAY YOUR WATER BILL WITH EASE!

#### **Permits for Swimming Pools**

Due to safety concerns, zoning certificates are now required for swimming pools that can hold more than 200 gallons of water and are not moved within 48 hours of being assembled.

Zoning Certificates are not required for pools with a capacity less than 200 gallons or that are assembled for less than 48 hours.

Residents may apply for a Zoning Certificate by completing a Swimming pool application form, which is available at the City Clerk's office or from the City's web-site, www.ci.chatfield.mn.us. Residents need to be issued a Zoning Certificate prior to placing pools within their property.
