SPRING CLEAN-UP;

POINTS TO PONDER....

Over the years, the annual spring clean-up has become a rite of the seasonal changes and a welcome one it is. Residents might want to be aware that this service has been increasing in cost, rising from approximately \$6,000 a few years ago to approximately \$11,000 at times. As those costs increase, naturally, thoughts turn to changing how this service works, or eliminating it altogether. This was one of those years, actually, when the City Council seriously debated the merits and costs of this service and, in the end, decided that the service is valuable to the residents. They are concerned about the rising costs, though.

In order to ensure this service in the future, residents are urged to use this service thoughtfully. The original intent was to provide a way for folks to dispose of large, bulky items, items that don't fit easily into the yellow bags. The intent was to eliminate the need for people to set stuff outside and let that stuff sit next to the garage where weeds might grow and vermin are attracted. Please use the service but if your items are small, please place those items out, in yellow bags, on your regular day of pick-up.

This service is funded by a portion of the fee that appears on your monthly utility bill. Enjoy the event!!



Recreational Fires

Burning is not allowed within the city limits with the exception of a recreational fire. To be classified as a recreational fire <u>ALL</u> of the following criteria MUST be met:

- The fire can be no larger than 3 feet by 3 feet by 3 feet.
- It must be surrounded by a fire ring.
- Only twigs and logs are to be burned.
- Someone must be in attendance at all times.

Please note: fire bans include recreational fires

City Wide Clean Up

The spring city-wide clean-up has been scheduled to begin Monday, May 8th.

- Place all unwanted items on the curb.
- Tires, batteries, fluorescent bulbs and other household hazardous waste will not be picked up.
- Appliances, televisions and computer monitors always need a sticker—these will be picked up on Thursday, May 11th.
- This is open to city residents only.

This is a valued but expensive service. It is intended to help with large, bulky, non-compactable items. Clothing and other items that can fit into the regular yellow bags should be placed in one. Please do not abuse this service. Thank you!

NOXIOUS WEEDS

Tall grasses and noxious weeds must be controlled within the city of Chatfield.

Grasses or weeds taller than eight (8) inches in height (or that have gone to seed) are in violation.

It is also a violation to allow any noxious weeds, as defined by Minnesota Statute, to grow within the city. Noxious weeds include Field Bindweed, Hemp, Purple Loosestrife, Garlic Mustard, Poison Ivy, Leafy Spurge, Perennial Sow Thistle, Bull Thistle, Canadian Thistle, Musk Thistle and Plumeless Thistle.
