CURFEWS— 17 Years old & under

The City's Curfew Ordinance has changed so that it now applies to everyone age 17 and under. A curfew is important to protect minors from criminal activity that occurs after the curfew hour, to protect minors from improper influences that prevail after the curfew hour and to assist parents in controlling the behavior of their minor chil-

dren. A curfew also protects the public from illegal acts of minors that might be committed after the curfew hour.

All sidewalks must be cleaned and made safe for use! Clean the sidewalks promptly and thoroughly. If you don't clean your sidewalk, the City does have the right to clean it for you and if they do, they will charge your property for all of the costs. Please clean your walks.

CURFEW- (CONTINUED)

parent or guardian, youth under the age of sixteen are not allowed to be out and about after 11:00 p.m. each day. Youth age 16 and 17 must be home by 12:00 midnight.

An exception to the ordinance allows a minor to travel directly to and from the location of employment to his or her place of residence. Another exception allows a minor to participate in, or to travel directly to an event which is a school activity.
