## DOG GONE IT!

#### DOG & CAT REGULATION AND LICENSING

All dogs and cats that are at least six months old are required to be licensed. Licenses are due by July 1 of each year. Each license is \$10 per year for neutered or spayed animals and \$20 per year if not neutered or spayed. To purchase a license, be prepared to show proof of your pet's rabies vaccination when you stop at the City Clerk's office.

Each residence is allowed a total of 4 pets, but no more than 2 of a species. So there may be 2 dogs and 2 cats at a residence, but 1 dog and 3 cats or 1 cat and 3 dogs would be in violation.

#### Please remember;

- Pick up after your dog when walking around town or running in the parks.
- Cats and dogs are not allowed to run at large. An owner could be charged with a petty misdemeanor.
- Any dog or cat found to be running at large in the City will be picked up and placed in the animal pound.
- Any resident of the City may humanely detain a dog or cat that is found on their property and promptly call the police department (867-3331) to request that the dog or cat be picked up.



### Recreational Fires

Burning is not allowed within the city limits with the exception of a recreational fire. To be classified as a recreational fire ALL of the following criteria MUST be met:

- The fire can be no larger than 3 feet by 3 feet by 3 feet.
- 2. It must be surrounded by a fire ring.
- 3. Only twigs and logs are to be burned.
- Someone must be in attendance at all times. Please note that fire bans include recreational fires.

#### **NOXIOUS WEEDS**

Tall grasses and noxious weeds must be controlled within the city of Chatfield.

Grasses or weeds taller than eight (8) inches in height (or that have gone to seed) are in violation.

It is also a violation to allow any noxious weeds, as defined by Minnesota Statute, to grow within the city. Noxious weeds include Field Bindweed, Hemp, Purple Loosestrife, Garlic Mustard, Poison Ivy, Leafy Spurge, Perennial Sow Thistle, Bull Thistle, Canadian Thistle, Musk Thistle and Plumeless Thistle.
