2021 PROPERTY TAXES AND FEES

Based on the preliminary tax levy that was established by the City Council in September, the City's tax levy will increase by no more than 3.98%. While water rates will increase a bit next year, sanitary sewer rates and garbage rates are not expected to increase.

SHOVEL YOUR SIDEWALKS

Sidewalks need to be cleared of all snow and ice as quickly and completely as possible and at least within 24 hours of the weather event.

- The entire width of the sidewalk must be cleared of snow and ice, down to the concrete.
- Remember to clear curb ramps and crosswalks for wheelchairs and strollers.
- If you are leaving for an extended time, find someone to shovel your walks.

3 PREVENT FROZEN PIPES

Cold weather can freeze pipes leading to burst that can lead to costly repairs.

- Disconnect hoses from your outside faucets and shut off the valve for the outside faucet that is inside your house.
- Keep doors open to rooms that contain plumbing.
- Ask someone to check your place while you are
- If the temperature of the water collected in a cup after running for 10 minutes is 38 degrees or below start running your water with a stream the diameter of a pencil and notify City Hall at 507-867-3810 so water bills can be adjusted accordingly.
