City Buildings Re-opening...

COVID—19 UPDATE



After nearly three months of the public buildings being closed to the public, the Thurber Building and The Chatfield Public Library will be reopening for in-person business **if necessary**. The continued use of technology is highly en-

couraged when possible. That being said, if an in-person visit is necessary, things will look and feel a little different in the buildings due to safety precautions.

Visitors will notice new COVID-19 signage and protective measures in place to help ensure physical distancing guidelines are being followed. Anyone visiting is requested to follow health and safety guidelines and keep their distance (6 feet) from employees and other visitors. Anyone visiting the city buildings is encouraged to wear a face covering for the protection of others. A cautious approach is being taken to protect the health and safety of employees and the community.

As previously mentioned the continued use of technology is encouraged to contact city staff (e-mail or telephone) as is the use of digital tools available on the city website for services that can be provided without an in-person visit. A drop box for paperwork is available outside the alley entrance at the Thurber Building.

Please be patient with us as we reopen. We understand this isn't the ideal way to interact but our employees and our community's safety and well-being is our highest priority.

Public access will be limited to the front counters, conference rooms, and designated public restrooms. Gatherings / meetings are limited to 10 or less.
