## **SHOVEL YOUR SIDEWALKS**



Sidewalks need to be cleared of all snow and ice as quickly and completely as possible and at least within 24 hours of the weather event.

- The entire width of the sidewalk must be cleared of snow and ice, down to the con-
- Remember to clear curb ramps and crosswalks for wheelchairs and strollers.
- If you are leaving for an extended time, find someone to shovel your walks.

#### **WINTER PARKING REMINDER**

- Move your vehicle off of the street if you plan to leave town.
- Avoid a citation or having your vehicle towed by removing your vehicle from the street anytime it is snowing.

## **PREVENT FROZEN PIPES**



Cold weather can freeze pipes leading to burst that can lead to costly repairs.

- Disconnect hoses from your outside faucets and shut off the valve for the outside faucet that is inside vour house.
- Keep doors open to rooms that contain plumbing.
- Ask someone to check your place while you are
- If the temperature of the water collected in a cup after running for 10 minutes is 38 degrees or below start running your water with a stream the diameter of a pencil and notify City Hall at 507-867-3810 so water bills can be adjusted accordingly.
