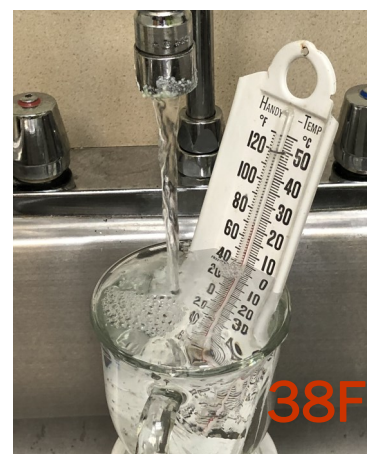

COLD TAP WATER—PREVENT FROZEN SERVICE LINES



Due to the cold weather conditions, residents of the city are advised to test the temperature of the water coming out of their taps.

To properly test your water temperature in your home or business, go to the faucet closest to where the water service comes into the building (usually in the basement). Set an indoor/outdoor thermometer (not a food thermometer) inside a cup under the faucet and run the water continuously into the cup until the temperature on the thermometer stabilizes (approximately 10 minutes). After running the water on the thermometer in the cup until the reading on the thermometer stops moving check the reading.



If the reading of the water temperature is 38 degrees Fahrenheit or lower, please run a stream of water the diameter of a pencil (continuously) and notify City Hall so your bill can be adjusted accordingly.

Generally a stream the diameter of a pencil is sufficient to avoid freezing but the farther your water temperature falls below 38 degrees, the stronger the stream needs to be. Once the water temperature reaches 38 degrees or below, it is likely that you will need to run that water until the ground thaws in the spring.

SHOVELING— HYDRANTS, SIDEWALK RAMPS & STORM DRAINS



If there is a **fire hydrant** near your house, please keep it accessible. In an emergency, every second counts. Remove any snow and ice from the hydrant, clear a wide enough perimeter around the hydrant for firefighters to work (about 3 feet), and clear a path from the street to the hydrant.

Sidewalks need to be cleared as quickly and completely as possible after a snowfall (within 24 hours). Please do not forget about **side-walk curb ramps** on corner lots and other curb cutouts. Residents are responsible for providing access from the street onto the sidewalk.

Please also clear away any snow that may be blocking a **storm drain** so when the thawing temperatures arrive the melting snow will clear the streets without creating large puddles and street flooding.
