These terms expire on January 31, 2022. An application can be obtained via email to jyoung@ci.chatfield.mn.us or by stopping at the Office of the City Clerk, 21 Second Street SE, Chatfield, MN.

Qualified individuals will be residents of the City of Chatfield and have a desire to serve their community as a volunteer.

The Charter Commission is made up of fifteen residents who are responsible for maintaining the City's Charter. The City Charter is, in effect, the City's constitution. The commission meets intermittently, at least once per year. Appointments to the Commission are made by the chief Judge of the Third Judicial District.

The City of Chatfield's Planning & Zoning commission is made up of seven residents who are responsible for maintaining the City's zoning ordinance, including the disposition of variances, conditional use permits and subdivision applications. The Commission meets on the councilorurban@ci.chatfield.mn.us first Monday of each month. Appointments to the Commission are made by the Mayor, with the confirmation of the City Council.



WARNING SIRENS

The City works with Olmsted County to test, maintain and activate the outdoor warning sirens in Chatfield. The purpose of the sirens is to warn people who are outdoors-while it is common for people within houses and other build-

ings to hear these sirens, it is actually expected that people indoors will be warned in other more effective ways, such as radio, television or special weather radio.

Siren Testing

- Apr 1-Oct 1 Full 3 min every Wednesday
- Oct 2-May 31, First Wednesday of the month 1 min. All other Wednesdays a quiet test
- 2. Tornado Warning by NWS Spotted funnel cloud by trained spotter 3.

1. Winds 70 mph or more

Siren Activation

4 Radar detected funnel cloud

Tests will not be conducted if there is rain or bad weather in the area.

For safety purposes, hunting is not allowed on the brush & leaf dump property.
